# 2006 DODGE CHARGER POLICE VEHICLE

- 160-mph or 260-km/h (certified) calibrated speedometer
- 18x7.5-inch steel wheels
- 3.5-liter V6 engine with 250 hp @ 6,400 rpm and 250 lb-ft of torque @ 3,800 rpm (based on regular unleaded fuel)
- 800 CCA battery
- AM/FM stereo radio with compact disc player, changer controls, four speakers, and clock with auxiliary audio input jack
- Bright hubcaps
- Easy path wiring grommet between underhood and passenger compartments
- External Oil Coolers: engine oil, transmission fluid, power steering fluid
- Five-speed automatic transmission with overdrive and AutoStick®
- Four-wheel disc heavy-duty antilock brakes with all-speed traction control
- Four-wheel independent performance suspension
- Heavy-duty cloth front bucket seats with manual lumbar and rear fixed cloth bench seat
- Instrument panel-mounted shift lever
- Load-leveling, height-control shock absorbers
- P225/60R18 BSW V-rated performance tires
- Police equipment mounting bracket
- Police performance Electronic Stability Program with Brake Assist (ESP)<sup>(1)</sup>

- Software-controlled alternating head- and taillamps (wigwag)
- Stealth mode switch (turns off instrument cluster and radio indicators; PRNDL dims to lowest legal limit)
- Three pairs of twisted 18-gauge wiring for sirens, speakers, or controls provided from interior to front bumper
- Underhood lamp

## OPTIONAL POLICE EQUIPMENT

- 18-inch bolt-on wheel covers
- 5.7L HEMI® V8 with Multi-Displacement System and 340 hp @ 5,000 rpm, 390 lb-ft of torque @ 4,000 rpm
- Daytime running lamps (U.S. market only)
- Easy-clean black vinyl floor covering
- Emergency rear door lock override
- Engine Block Heater
- Entire fleet keyed alike (without alarm)
- Fixed vinyl rear bench seat
- Front door body-side molding delete
- Full-size spare tire and wheel with battery cover and cargo compartment floor mat
- Independently switched white and LED red dome lamp
- Power eight-way driver's seat
- Rear inside door locks and handles deactivated
- Rear windows inoperative from rear seat
- Side-curtain air bags,<sup>(3)</sup> front and rear passenger<sup>(4)</sup>
- Spot lamp driver's side or dual (Black or Chrome)

## ALL DODGE CHARGER POLICE MODELS INCLUDE:

- **Air Bags<sup>(5)</sup>** – Advanced, multistage driver- and front-passenger air bags with Occupant Classification System (OCS)<sup>(6)</sup>
- **Air Conditioning** – Manual
- **Brake-Park Interlock** – Driver must apply brake before shifting from Park
- **Defroster** – Electric, rear window
- **Gauges** – 160-mph speedometer, tachometer, odometer, trip odometer, fuel level and coolant temperature, outside temperature
- **Indicators** (up to 18 depending on equipment) – Warning lamps for low oil pressure, charging system, low fuel and low washer fluid, seat belt reminder, door/trunk ajar, cruise, brake system, headlamp high beam, turn signals, engine, and air bag

- **Instrument Cluster**
- **Keyless Entry/Illuminated Entry**

  - Exterior – Quad halogen headlamps with automatic off feature, taillamps and center high-mounted stoplamp
  - Interior – Dual front map lamps, trunk lamp
- **Mirrors**
  - Exterior – Dual power
  - Interior – Day/night center rearview
- **Seat Belts**
  - Front – Height-adjustable, outboard shoulder belts, three-point
  - Rear – Non-height-adjustable shoulder belts, three-point
- **Speed Control**
- **Steering Column** – Tilt, height-adjustable
- **Windows** – Power with driver's one-touch-down feature
- **Wiper System** – Windshield, two-speed with speed-sensitive intermittent modes
